PUBLIC HEARING

1. 2017 Final Budget Hearing – Mayor Sweet opened the public hearing for the 2017 budget @ 7:05 p.m. The Mayor asked for questions or comments. City Administrator Steve Goemmel told the City Council that the City of Davenport was awarded a T.I.B. grant to replace the retaining wall on 7th Street. This grant requires some matching funds and those changes are incorporated into the final draft of the 2017 budget. Steve commented that he hoped to adopt the 2017 budget on December 14, 2016. The Mayor asked for further comments or questions. There were none.
