**NEW BUSINESS**

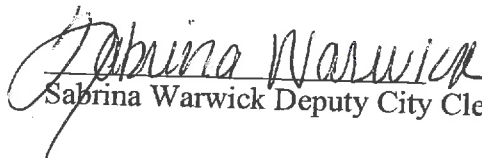
