

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE DAVENPORT CITY COUNCIL**  
**January 10, 2018**

**ROLL CALL**

Mayor Brad Sweet called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Council Members present were: Nathan Hansen, Corey Hollis, Patrick Katz, Pete Schweiger, Lance Strite, and Theresa Telford.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Pat Katz made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 27, 2017 meeting. The motion was seconded by Nathan Hansen. The motion carried.

**POLICE REPORT**

Deputy Gants reported 50 calls for service in the month of December. He told the City Council that the total number of calls for the year was 918. Deputy Gants introduced Deputy Andy Manke to the City Council. Deputy Manke told the City Council how much he liked working in Davenport. Andy introduced Deputy Kurt Cuzzetto to City Council. Kurt is a new hire at the Sheriff's office. Deputy Cuzzetto introduced himself to the City Council. Kurt told the City Council that he looked forward to working with them and serving the community.
