

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE DAVENPORT CITY COUNCIL**  
**June 12, 2019**

**ROLL CALL**

Mayor Brad Sweet called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Council Members present were: Pat Katz, Cory Hollis, Nathan Hansen, Lance Strite, Pete Schweiger, and Theresa Telford.

Absent: Chris Ruiz

Motion to Excuse: Lance Strite made a motion to excuse Chris Ruiz from the meeting. The motion was seconded by Theresa Telford. The motion carried.

Also present were Fred Bell, Gabe Gants, Steve Goemmel, Tyler Groom, Craig Sweet, and Marcia Smith.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Nathan Hansen made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 22, 2019 meeting. The motion was seconded by Pete Schweiger. The motion carried.

**POLICE REPORT**

Deputy Gabe Gants reported 111 calls for service in the month of May. The Deputy told the City Council that more than half the calls were traffic stops. Deputy Gants commented that the number of calls typically go up in the summertime. Mayor Sweet thanked the Deputy for his report and his service to the community.

**CONFIRMATION OF AGENDA**

Mayor Sweet added "Resolution 2019-08 Allowing the Mayor to enter into a Purchase and Sales Agreement to Purchase an Airport Hangar" to New Business.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Fire/Police Committee

Nathan Hansen reported that the Committee met to discuss the city-county agreement for fire services with representatives of Lincoln County Fire District 5. Nathan said they discussed the possibility of the fire district annexing in the City of Davenport. Nathan said that this was a preliminary meeting and the committee had no recommendation at this time.

**MAYOR'S REPORT**

Mayor Sweet told the City Council that the 2020 Census is on the way. He said that the kids at Davenport Middle school had a fun day in the pool and everyone enjoyed themselves. The Mayor read apology letters from juveniles in Davenport who committed minor offenses and were making amends. The Mayor publicly thanked them for the letters.

**OLD BUSINESS**

*1. Fourth Reading of Ordinance 1139 Making a Necessary Addition to Chapter 12.20 of the Davenport Municipal Code Dealing with Streets, Safety, and Snow Removal. City Administrator Steve Goemmel suggested some minor changes to this ordinance to make parallel parking mandatory in the area of 10<sup>th</sup> Street and Morgan Street. The City Council agreed to these changes.*

Lance Strite made a motion to approve Ordinance 1139 Making a Necessary Addition to Chapter 12.20 of the Davenport Municipal Code Dealing with Streets, Safety, and Snow Removal at its fourth and final reading. The motion was seconded by Patrick Katz. The motion carried.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

*1. Resolution 2019-08 Allowing the Mayor to Enter Into a Purchase and Sales Agreement to Purchase an Airport Hanger.* City Manager Steve Goemmel told the City Council that there is a hanger for sale at the Davenport Airport. He commented that the City has first right of refusal on the hangers at the airport. He showed the City Council a market analysis for the hanger. He told the City Council that the City could use the hanger for tourism and emergency purposes. The hanger could also be rented on a temporary basis to help pay for it. He asked the City Council if they had an interest in buying the hanger. The City Council discussed the issue and decided to purchase the hanger.

Nathan Hansen made a motion to approve Resolution 2019-08. The motion was seconded by Theresa Telford. The motion carried.

### **APPROVAL TO PAY BILLS**

Pete Schweiger made a motion to pay Claims/Vouchers #15607 - #15644 in the amount of \$106,432.53 and Payroll/Vouchers #15582-#15606 in the Amount of \$57,589.24. The motion was seconded by Nathan Hansen. The motion carried.

Theresa Telford made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Pat Katz. The motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
