


# WEIGHT LIMIT RESTRICTIONS

OVER 12,000 POUND GROSS  
BY PERMIT ONLY  
EXCEPT ON TRUCK ROUTES  
APPLY AT CITY HALL



## ORDINANCE NO. 894

AN ORDINANCE BY THE DAVENPORT CITY COUNCIL TO AMEND CHAPTER 10.32 WHICH RELATES TO LOAD LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAVENPORT, WASHINGTON:

### SECTION I

That Section 10.32.010 Surfaced streets, which presently reads: (a) All oil-surface streets in the city except as set forth in section 10.32.050 are closed to vehicles whose gross weight, (vehicle and load), exceed ten thousand pounds. Local deliveries by vehicles which exceed these limits will be allowed over the shortest practical path from the closest exempted street by permit only. (b) The following vehicles are specifically exempted for the above load limits:

- (1) School buses for travel to or from school;
- (2) Municipal or utilities vehicles such as snowplows, garbage trucks, electric power trucks, etc.;
- (3) Emergency vehicles such as fire trucks, ambulances, police vehicles, etc.

Be amended to read: Section 10.32.010 Surfaced Streets. (a) All oil-surface streets in the city except as set forth in Section 10.32.050 are closed to vehicles whose gross weight, (vehicle and load), exceed twelve thousand pounds. Local deliveries by vehicles which exceed these limits will be allowed over the shortest practical path from the closest exempted street by permit only from DECEMBER 1ST THROUGH MAY 1ST. (b) The following vehicles are specifically exempted for the above load limits:

- (1) School buses for travel to or from school;
- (2) Municipal or utilities vehicles such as snowplows, garbage trucks, electric power trucks, etc.;
- (3) Emergency vehicles such as fire trucks, ambulances, police vehicles, etc.

### SECTION II

That Section 10.32.050 Exceptions, which presently reads: This chapter does not apply to the operation of vehicles in the following streets:

- (1) Morgan Street- State Highway No. 2;
- (2) Twelfth Street from Morgan Street to city limits south;
- (3) Sixth Street north from Park Street to city limits;
- (4) Park Street from Seventh Street to Harker Street;
- (5) Logan Street from Eighth Street to Fifth Street;
- (6) Eight Street from Morgan Street to Logan Street;
- (7) Seventh Street from Park Street to Morgan Street;
- (8) Harker Street from Park Street to Morgan Street;
- (9) Fifth Street from Morgan Street to Logan Street;
- (10) Eighth Street from Morgan Street to Park Street;
- (11) Sinclair Street from Third Street to Fifth Street;
- (12) Third Street (exempt from may 1 through October 30). (May be posted nonexempt from November 1 through April 30 by order of the Mayor).
- (13) Jefferson, beginning at Twelfth Street thence east to Seventh Street, thence south on Seventh Street to the alley south of Jefferson, thence east to Third

Street on said alley (exempt from May 1 through April 30 by order of the Mayor).

Be amended to read: Section 10.32.050 Exceptions. This chapter does not apply to the operation of vehicles on the following streets:

- (1) Morgan Street-State Highway No. 2;
- (2) Twelfth Street from Morgan Street to city limits south;
- (3) Sixth Street north from Park Street to city limits;
- (4) Park Street from Seventh Street to Harker Street;
- (5) Logan Street from Eighth Street to
- (6) fifth Street;
- (7) Eighth Street from Morgan Street to Logan Street;
- (8) Seventh Street from Park Street to Logan Street;
- (9) Harker Street from Park Street to Morgan Street;
- (10) Fifth Street from Morgan Street to Logan Street;
- (11) Sinclair Street from Third to Fifth Street;
- (12) Third Street;
- (13) Jefferson, beginning at Twelfth Street thence east to Seventh Street to the alley south of Jefferson, thence east to Third Street on said alley;
- (14) Sinclair Street from Fifth Street to Seventh Street;
- (15) Seventh Street from Sinclair Street to Logan Street;
- (16) Seventh Street from Morgan Street to Washington Street;
- (17) Washington Street from Seventh Street to Sixth Street;
- (18) First Street from Highway 2 to Park Street;
- (19) Park Street from Third Street to First Street;
- (20) Eight Street from Jefferson Street to Fitness Lane;
- (21) Monroe Street from Fourteenth Street to Eighth Street;
- (22) Tenth Street from Jefferson Street to Monroe Street;
- (23) Morgan Street from Second Street to First Street;
- (24) Ninth Street from Morgan Street to Park Street;
- (25) Park Street from Ninth Street to Eighth Street.

All truck routes are subject to restrictions during the Spring and the condition of asphalt.

### SECTION III

That Section 10.32.020 Pneumatic tires, which presently reads: High pressure pneumatic tires shall have the same rating as set forth in Section 10.32.010.

That Section 10.32.020 be removed in its entirety.

That Section 10.32.030 Allowance, which presently reads: No allowance will be made for any second rear axle that is suspended from the frame of a vehicle independent of the regular driving axle, and commonly known as a "rigid trail axle". Allowance will be made for single tires only, on the front axle of any truck.

That Section 10.32.030 be removed in its entirety.

That Section 10.32.040 Load distribution, the load distribution on any one axle of any vehicle shall be such that it will not load the tires on said axle in excess of the prescribed load set forth in Section 10.32.010.


That Section 10.32.040 be removed in its entirety.


